ABOUT YOUR STAY

Your Key

The key for your room will open your room door and the main door to the building (the Garden entrance).

We close and lock all the main doors at 10.00pm, so if you are intending to return later please ensure you have your room key with you.

On the morning of your departure, please leave your room key on the desk in your room.

Any lost or removed keys will incur a replacement charge of £20 per key.

Breakfast Service

A cooked breakfast is included in the cost of your room, and is served in the downstairs dining room between 8.00 and 9.30am. Please ensure that you have completed and handed in our Breakfast Choices leaflet the night before.

If you have an early start it may be possible to provide you with a breakfast box containing a selection of pastries and yoghurt. Please check with your hosts for more information.

Housekeeping

Daily housekeeping is provided for guests staying for more than one night, and consists of bed making, the replenishment of refreshments plus the emptying of bins if necessary.

If you require any additional services or linen/towel changes, please enquire at reception. A small charge may be levied depending on what is required.

Free WiFi

All rooms are connected to our fibre-optic internet router via a mesh system. This is normally of sufficient speed and bandwidth to enable streaming of TV and film content, but may be affected by local weather conditions or outages.

The network to use in our guest bedrooms is named **Glenerne Guests**, and the password you will need to access the service is **Glenerne2025!**

Your TV

Your room TV is enabled for all the main satellite and streaming channels including Netflix and BBC iPlayer. We ask that you do not connect any other devices to your room TV.

Energy Use

In line with our published Environmental Policy, we are committed to using energy and other resources sparingly, and with consideration to our overall carbon footprint. Therefore we ask that you switch off any lights and/or other appliances when they are not in use.

Your room temperature can be adjusted using the thermostatic valves on each radiator, and on colder nights we would recommend closing the window shutters to help conserve heat.

Local Contractors

In support of Scotland's bold renewable energy policies, we are happy to occasionally welcome skilled and professional engineers to The Glenerne. Therefore please do not be alarmed if you encounter someone dressed in their full safety gear!

SMOKING & VAPING

Smoking and/or vaping is not permitted anywhere within the building(s) including bedrooms and all public areas.

It is permitted in the garden area providing that it is conducted well away from any other guests, and that any butts or used vapes are disposed of responsibly.

ABOUT YOUR SAFETY

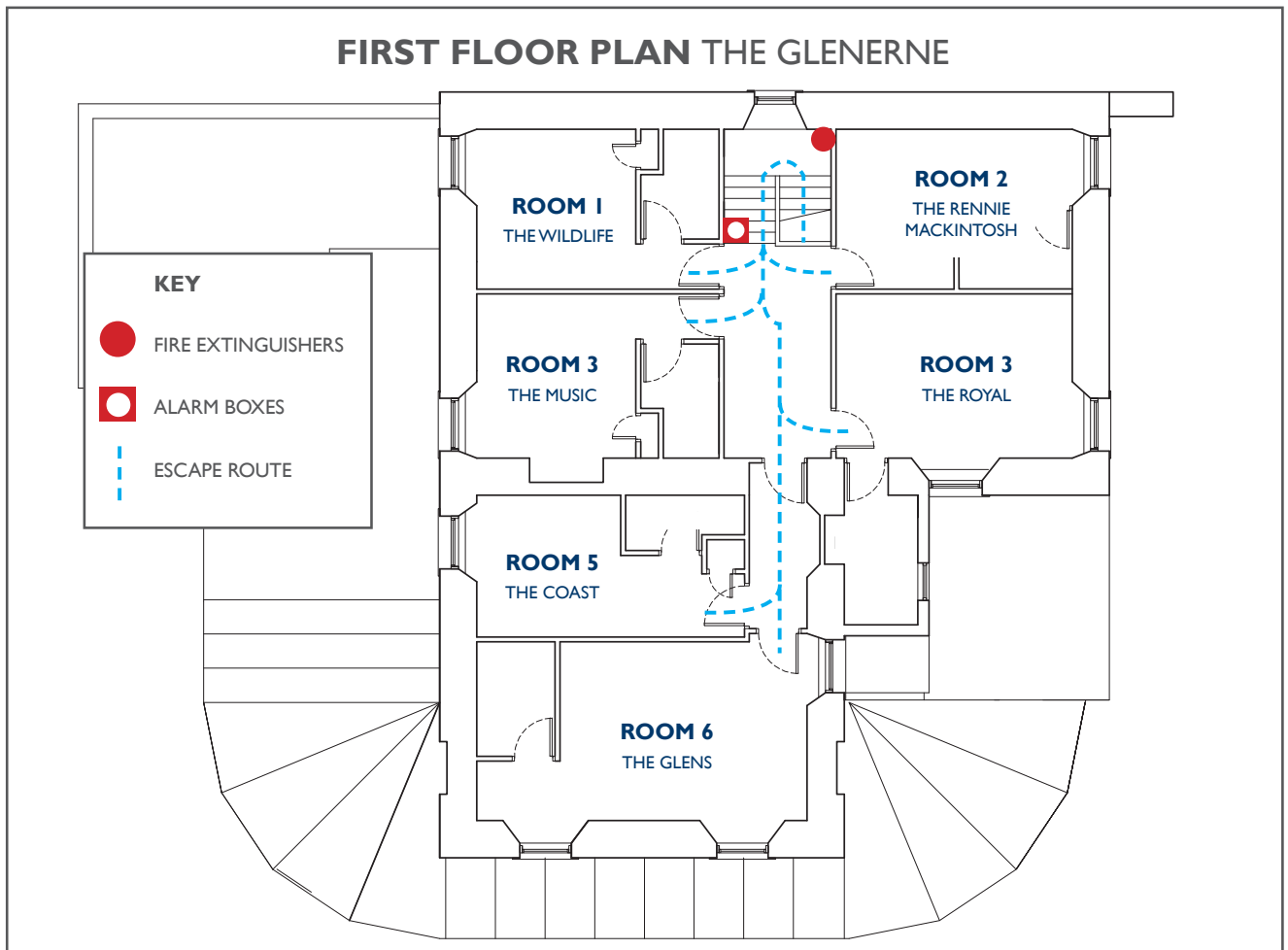
Your safety is of paramount importance to us. Because of this, we have some essential guidance that we would ask you to observe throughout your stay:

1. Please read the fire safety instructions displayed on your bedroom door, and familiarise yourself with the location of the fire alarm boxes and fire extinguishers (diagram below).
2. If you are using heated hair styling equipment in your room (hair dryer, hair straighteners, hair tongs, etc.) please place these on the heat resistant slate mat provided when in use. After use please ensure that they are switched off and unplugged from the mains.
3. In the event of a fire, make your way down the main staircase, along the main corridor and out through the main door. Once you are outside please

walk to the covered patio area in the garden and remain there until you are told that it is safe to return to the building. Emergency lighting will operate throughout the building to help guide your safe passage in the event of any power loss or smoke.

4. Smoking and/or vaping are not permitted anywhere in the building. There is, however, a covered patio in the garden that you may use providing it does not impact on any other guests. The bin next to the entrance gate may be used for the disposal of extinguished cigarette butts.

5. The use of candles is not permitted in any of the guest rooms. If you would like to create a candlelit atmosphere in your room, please ask us for some of our battery operated tea lights.

LOCAL MAP & FACILITIES



Parking

There are three main car parks in Eyemouth (see map above), two of which are very close to The Glenerne and all of which are free.

In addition there is unrestricted parking on nearby residential streets, or paid parking at the harbourside. Most facilities are within easy walking distance from The Glenerne so parking is seldom an issue.

The Harbour

Eyemouth has a busy commercial harbour, with plenty to see and do. There are numerous restaurants, pubs and cafés to choose from, and a large outside seating area.

As well as food and drink, there is the opportunity to take a boat or sea fishing trip, discover the town's smuggling history at Gunsgreen House or the Eyemouth Museum, or maybe even feed the harbour's resident seals from the kiosk on the quayside.

Please take care when in the harbour area, and be vigilant for commercial vehicles (including forklifts) and the swooping seagulls!

The Beach and Promenade

Eyemouth's sandy beach is a clean and safe place to walk, swim and relax. At low tide there are rock pools to explore, and when the wind strength and direction allows it is an excellent spot for paddleboarding or kayaking.

The promenade runs parallel with the high street and the area offers a choice of independent shops, cafés and restaurants. There is also a supermarket, an amusement arcade with bowling, plus a leisure centre with indoor pool and gym.

Coastal Walking

East and west of Eyemouth you can walk for miles along a spectacular coastline, using well signposted and maintained pathways. The area is a protected marine reserve where you'll see a huge variety of bird and aquatic species, as well as some incredible rock formations.

Head east towards Berwick for rugged and dramatic scenery and a challenging workout, or west towards St. Abbs for the sands of Coldingham Bay and the charming fishing port.

Giacopazzi's Ice Cream Parlour (Harbourside)

A great place to sample the many different ice cream flavours, coffees and cakes, and watch the boats and people go by.

Oblo's Bistro (Harbourside)

Pet and people-friendly bistro restaurant offering quality menus for lunch and dinner, or a leisurely morning coffee.

The Contented Sole (Harbourside)

Traditional Scottish pub with a great value menu and a selection of local brews. Seating upstairs and downstairs with a small outside terrace strictly for when the sun is out.

Eyemouth Golf Club

An amazing panoramic view of Eyemouth, the golf course and the open ocean from the first floor family restaurant. Typical pub menu with reasonable prices - we call it Wetherspoons with a view!

Eyemouth Rib Trips (Harbourside)

Take a ride along the coast on the modern 16-seater RIB 'Clearwater', hosted by skipper Tim and his partner Laura. A well run and informative experience that shows you the best of the area from a different viewpoint.

Feed the Seals (Harbourside)

For a small fee you'll get a rod with a metal clip, and a bucket of fish pieces. Clip the fish onto the line and dangle it over the small platform below. The seals will jump up to take the fish if the gulls haven't managed to steal it first!

Saffron Indian Restaurant (High Street)

Recently opened but already building a great reputation, a comfortable and friendly Indian with a wide choice of traditional and speciality dishes.

Chu Hoi Chinese Takeaway (Chapel Street)

The usual fare but always well presented and tasty. One of the best in the area - cash only.
